

The chart and information below outline the legislated requirements to work under the COVID-19 Protection Framework (CPF).

## Health Service – Vaccine pass not required

- Designated premises with <u>HPCA 2003</u> practitioners
- Settings such as hospitals, midwifery centres, GP clinics etc
- Those who receive funding from agencies listed below\*\*
- Practice pursuant to the amended <u>Health</u> Order
- Shared / single entrance to premises with any of the above
- Not able to discriminate between vaccinated and non-vaccinated clients

# Close contact business – Vaccine pass required

- Anyone not receiving funding from agencies listed below
- Single practitioner who has their own premises
- Shared space with separate entrance and bathroom facilities
- Share space with no practitioners who fall under 'Health Services'
- Refer clients to other services or MT working in a designated premise

All infection protection control, health, hygiene and safety protocols to be followed in both categories.

Pre-screening of clients for COVID-19 is paramount to protect yourself and your clients

### Ventilation

- Change of air flow
  - Open window / door
  - Ventilate between clients
- HEPA filter / air purifier (beware of charlatans)
- More guidance from MOH to follow

#### Masks

- Surgical recommended
- N95 not required
